Addressing NTMs in the RCEP Region



- <u>Takeaway 1</u>: (Low-hanging fruit) Establish mechanisms to effectively identify and eliminate/address NTBs/NTMs
 - clear criteria on identification and removal of NTBs with mechanisms in place for regular reviews
- <u>Takeaway 2</u>: (Most significant challenge) Harmonise standards, technical regulations and conformity assessment procedures in alignment with international practices and develop MRAs.
 - Priority: Labelling (nutrition labelling) and Product Registration (within the pre-market approval process)
- <u>Takeaway 3:</u> Simplify/eliminate unnecessary elements and duplication in customs and certification procedures
 - Adopting best practices (e.g. advance rulings, rational/liberal set of origin criteria, selfcertification system on Rules of Origin, e-certificate of origin, etc.)
- <u>Takeaway 4</u>: Institutionalisation of regular dialogues/ consultations/ interactions between government and business sector to discuss RCEP initiatives/issues
